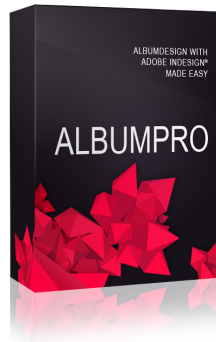

AlbumPro how-to ? + instructions

AlbumPro 2 - Installation Guide

- AlbumPro 2 comes with an installation script that will copy all files to the correct target directory.

These are the steps to proceed with the setup script.

1. Download AlbumPro 2 from www.album-pro.com
2. Extract the ZIP File to your **DESKTOP**.

As a result you have the following structure on your desktop:

3. Start Adobe InDesign and create a new document. (size does not matter)
4. Go to the folder AlbumPro_V2 and start the **Install_AlbumPro.jsx** script with a double click.
5. Once the Setup is running, you'll get a notification if you want to run a script from an unknown source.
Click **Yes** to proceed.
6. In InDesign you will get another message that shows the folder name where the sourcefiles are located.
Click **OK** to proceed.
7. Once the Setup is finished you get a final notification to restart Adobe InDesign and Bridge.
8. As a final step you need to add the library with the templates to InDesign.
Move to the following folder on your system and double click on the .indl file.
Mac: /Users/##USERNAME##/Library/Application Support/AlbumPro
PC: C:\Users\##USERNAME##\AppData\Roaming\AlbumPro
9. In InDesign you should see a new menu called **AlbumPro**.
In Bridge you should see **Template Selector** in the Tools Menu

If you do not see this menus, something went wrong. Please proceed on the next page.

■ If you had to continue to this page, something went wrong with the automated installation.

Don't worry. All you need to do is to copy a couple of files.

1. Download AlbumPro 2 from www.album-pro.com
2. Extract the ZIP File to your **DESKTOP**.

As a result you have the following structure on your desktop:

3. Copy the Folder AlbumPro (including all subfolders) from the source to the following target directory
Mac: /Users/##USERNAME##/Library/Application Support/AlbumPro
PC: C:\Users\##USERNAME##\AppData\Roaming\AlbumPro
4. Copy the File **analyze_selected_imgs.jsxbin** from the Folder Bridge to the following target directory
Mac: /Users/##USERNAME##/Library/Application Support/Adobe/Bridge CS#(Version)/Startup Scripts
PC: C:\Users\##USERNAME##\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\Bridge CS#(Version)\Startup Scripts
5. Copy the content of the Folder InDesign (including all subfolders) from the source to the following target directory
Mac: /Users/##USERNAME##/Library/Preferences/Adobe InDesign/Version (version)/(language)/Scripts
PC: C:\Users\##USERNAME##\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\InDesign\Version (version)\(language)\Scripts
6. As a final step you need to add the library with the templates to InDesign.
Move to the following folder on your system and double click on the .indl file.
Mac: /Users/##USERNAME##/Library/Application Support/AlbumPro
PC: C:\Users\##USERNAME##\AppData\Roaming\AlbumPro
7. In InDesign you should see a new menu called **AlbumPro**.
In Bridge you should see **Template Selector** in the Tools Menu
